### **Farm Dog Certification Tests – Open to All Breeds**

The AKC Farm Dog Certified (FDC) Test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or neutered dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not participate. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the entire course.

**ENTRY INFORMATION – FARM DOG TEST**

**ENTRY FEES: Pre-entries: \$30 Per Dog Per Run**

**Day of Entries: \$35 Per Dog Per Run**

Fees include AKC \$3.50 recording fee. Make checks payable to **CVKC. Cash or Check Only**

Day of Test 1 Entries Close at 11 AM

Day of Test 2 Entries Close at 2 PM

**Day of entries will be accepted if space is available in either test. Pre-entries will run first.**

Drawing for running order will be made Thursday, April 11, and pre-entry registrants will be contacted by e-mail.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries on the day of the test. Please type or print clearly & carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

CVKC may remove any dog on any account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against the aforementioned club or any official or member thereof. Entry fees will not be refunded in the

event a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered test, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be added to an alternates list in the order entry was received. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the event entered.

**PRIZES:** Each dog that passes a Farm Dog Certification Test will receive a dark green ribbon.

Dogs that pass Farm Dog Certification Tests under two different judges are eligible for a Farm Dog Certified Title. Application forms for the title will be available on the day of the test.. Owners will need to complete the application form and send it and the appropriate fee to the American Kennel Club. CVKC will not do this submission for exhibitors.

### **EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:**

- Check In will begin at **7:30 AM**
- Test 1 runs will begin at **8 AM**
- Test 2 runs will begin after noon.
- Dogs must wear a secure, well-fitting **flat collar** during the test evaluation and be held on a proper fixed-length leash at all times while on the farm site unless confined in a crate, kennel or vehicle. The leash shall be four to six feet in length. No prong or electronic collars, head halters, harnesses or flexi-leads are permitted on the premises.
- **NO FLEXI-TYPE RETRACTABLE LEASHES ALLOWED** on site.
- You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of waste in the proper receptacles. A failure to do so could result in you and your dog being dismissed from the trial grounds and be barred from competing.
- Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the farm animals nor to interfere outside the testing area with another dog's performance in the test areas. The Judge may request the removal of any dog from the immediate test area at any time if she determines the presence of the dog presents a risk to livestock, other dogs or persons on the farm.
- Un-entered dogs are NOT allowed in the test areas.
- Bitches in season may not be brought onto the test site.
- All dogs must have current vaccinations for rabies. Please bring a copy of rabies certificate with you.
- These tests are held on private property. You must obey all rules.
- Children must be accompanied by and kept under the direct supervision of an adult at all times.

NOTE: Bring your own chair and water for your dogs. Dress appropriately for the weather. There will be a port a potty but no concessions. **Overnight parking is not available.**

### **DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE:**

From the East take Route 89 to Exit 12 for VT-2A toward US-2/Williston/Essex Junction. Turn left onto VT-2A South for .7 miles. Turn right onto Walker Hill Road for .6 miles. Turn left onto South Brownell Rd for .2 miles. Turn right onto Van Sicklen Rd for .3 miles. Turn left onto Blue Heron Drive. Farm will be .2 miles straight ahead.

From the West take Route 89 to Exit 12 for VT-2A. Turn right onto VT-2A South and follow directions above.

## **FARM DOG CERTIFICATION TEST ELEMENTS:**

Test elements may be arranged in any order with the exception of the first and last element (#1 & #12)

1. Greet Judge – initial dog appraisal
2. Perform a walking pattern around farm environment/passive stranger
3. Jump on hay/straw bale
4. Walk by farm animals
5. Walk over or through unusual surfaces
6. Supervised separation
7. Pass through a gate
8. Handler feeds livestock
9. Reaction to another dog
10. Reaction to noise distraction
11. Dog approaches livestock
12. Physical examination
